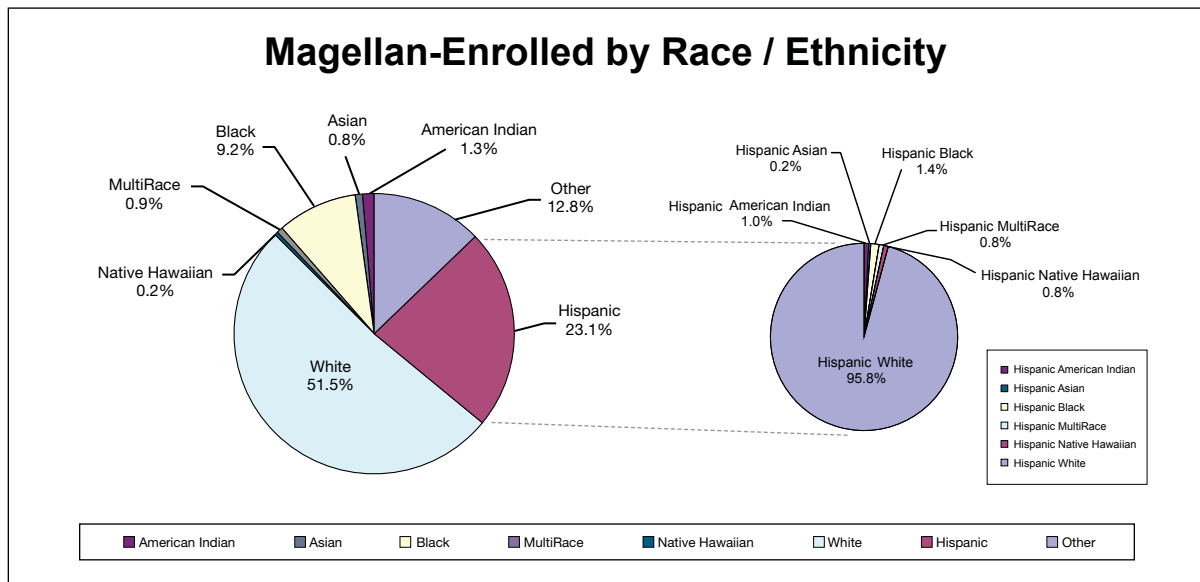
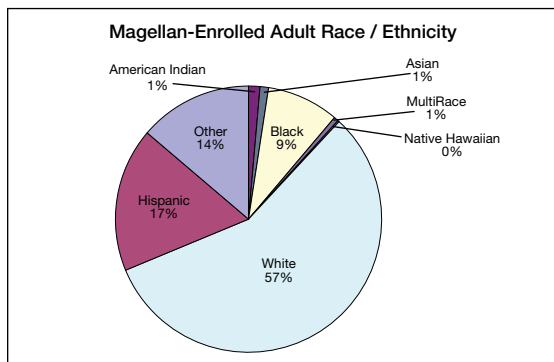


Maricopa Regional Behavioral Health Authority Demographic Profile

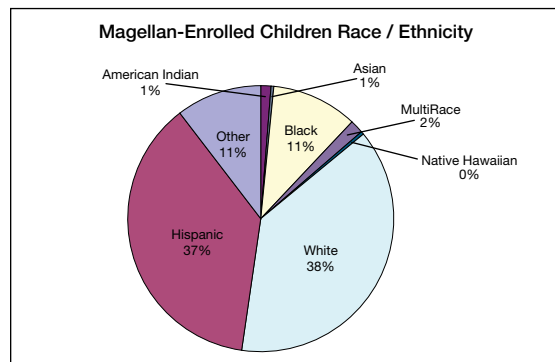
Approximately 80,000 individuals currently receive mental health services through the Maricopa County Regional Behavioral Health Authority, which is administered by Magellan Health Services of Arizona. The following charts profile these recipients of care.



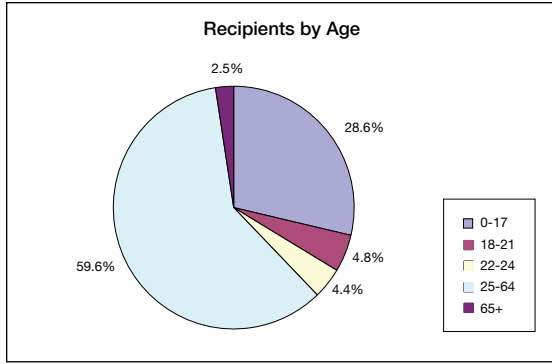
Almost one-quarter of all recipients are of Hispanic ethnicity.



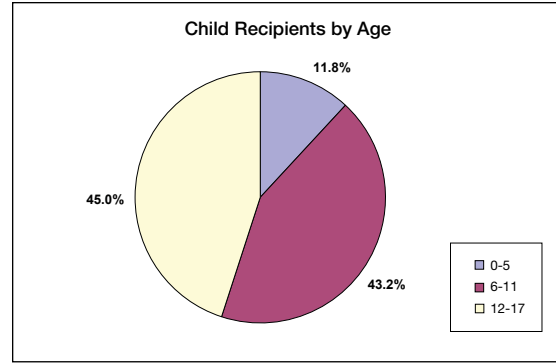
Forty-three percent of adult recipients are non-White.



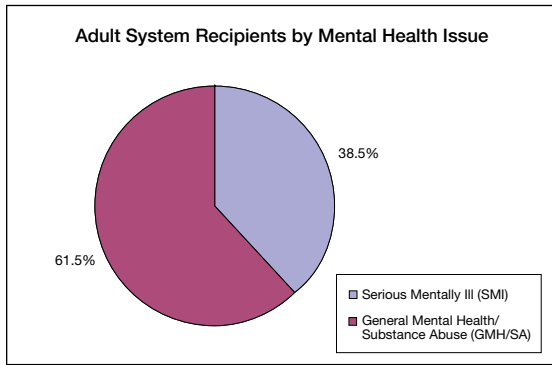
Sixty-two percent of child recipients are non-White.



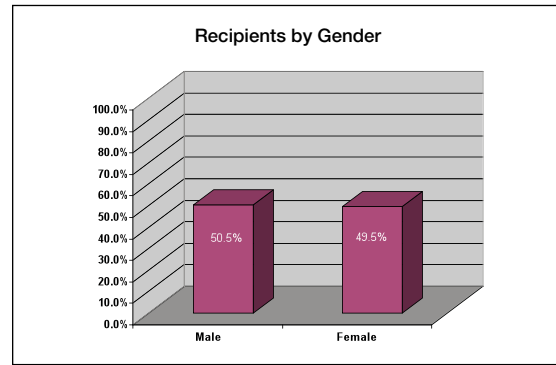
Children and young adults make up more than one-third of recipients, and more than half of recipients are between the ages of 25 and 64.



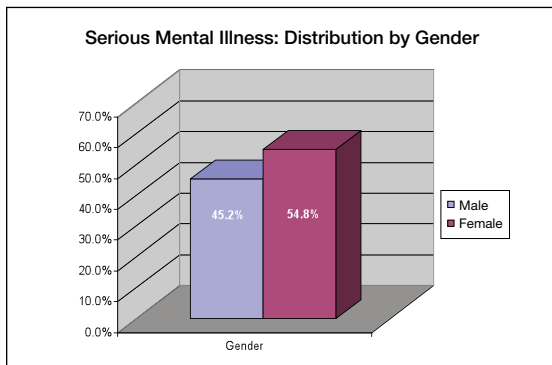
Almost half of child recipients fall in the 12-17 age range.



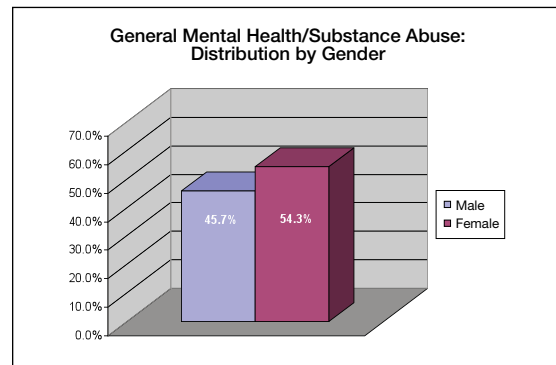
Almost two-thirds of recipients in the Adult System have general mental health or substance abuse issues.



In terms of gender, recipients are split almost evenly between male and female.



Women make up the majority of recipients with serious mental illness (SMI).



The percentages of male and female recipients receiving services for general mental health or substance abuse issues are about the same as those in the SMI category.
