Revision to PM Section 3.18 Pre-Petition Screening, Court-Ordered Evaluation, and Court-Ordered Treatment

Magellan is modifying language in PM Section 3.18, Pre-Petition Screening, Court-Ordered Evaluation, and Court-Ordered Treatment; sub-section 3.18.7-B, Pre-Petition Screening. These changes are effective immediately and are identified below in tracked change format. These changes will also be posted to the Provider Manual shortly.

When the county is contracted with the RBHA for pre-petition screening services
Magellan does not contract directly with Maricopa County for pre-petition screening. There is an intergovernmental agreement between Maricopa County and the Arizona Department of Health Services which requires Magellan to provide pre-petition screening and court ordered evaluation for residents of Maricopa County for these services. In turn, ADHS/DBHS contracts with Magellan to provide Pre-Petition Screening and Court-Ordered Evaluation Services.
