COMMUNITY RESOURCE FAIRS

Arizona is facing its worst economic crisis ever. Because of this, funding for many state services has been reduced and, in some cases, is no longer available.

In March, the Arizona Legislature passed a budget that significantly cut funding for behavioral health services. These cuts caused changes for Magellan recipients who receive services and who are not eligible for the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS, Arizona's Medicaid program), also known as Title XIX (19).

To ensure you understand how these changes will affect you, Magellan has implemented a safe and responsible transition plan that includes helping you connect to community-based resources.

AHCCCS Eligibility Screening Check List

- Proof of any income from the last 30 days (pay stubs, unemployment, social security, child support, etc.)
- Driver license
- Social Security card (*for each applicant*)
- Birth certificate (*for each applicant*)
- Utility bill (*if applicable*)
- Letter from neighbor or someone who knows you confirming who lives with you (*letter must include your address, their address, name and phone number*).

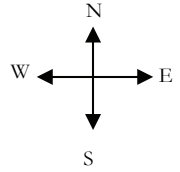
Resource Fair Bus Route Maps



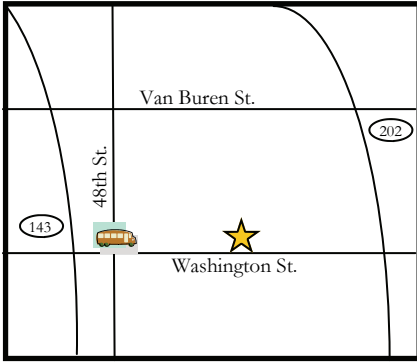
Valley Metro Bus Stop



Community Resource Fair Location

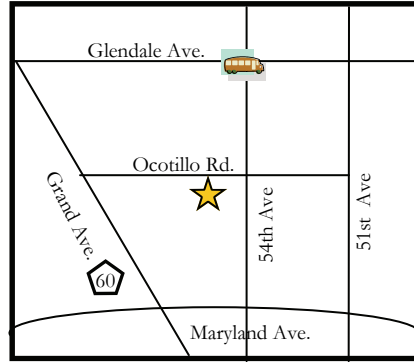

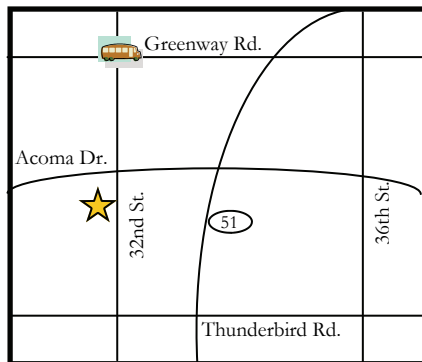

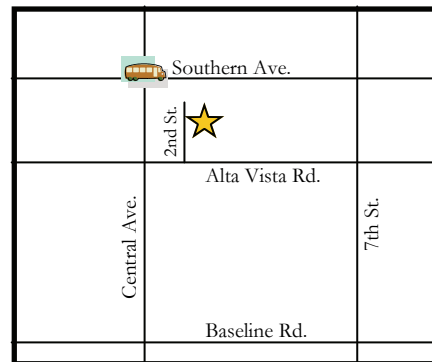
