Magellan of Arizona serves more than 70,000 members in Maricopa County, with an outreach to 500,000 people within our network of care. Services are provided to those who have a covered behavioral health benefit through the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment system (AHCCCS), KidsCare (Title XXI) or through other state agencies with whom Magellan of Arizona partners. Services are paid by a contract with the



Arizona Department of Health Services/Division of Behavioral Health Services and AHCCCS.

Our Network of Providers

Magellan of Arizona oversees the operations and management of 23 direct care clinics, located throughout Maricopa County, and one urgent psychiatric care center in downtown Phoenix. Magellan is in the process of transferring its direct care services to Provider Network Organizations (PNOs), which provide behavioral health services to adults and children. Through the management of these PNOs, Magellan maintains a family of more than 100 providers and direct care clinics throughout Maricopa County that give our

members choices in their path to recovery. The providers vary by gender, specialty (type of treatment provided), languages spoken and location.

A Commitment to Arizona

Magellan of Arizona is committed to building a community driven model of behavioral health care in Maricopa County. Central to this promise is a 12-member community and Magellan-staffed Maricopa County Governance Board, which oversees the vision, strategy, planning and implementation of our work. Magellan also offers a host of volunteer advisory committees which meet regularly to help guide our network of care, and includes family members, advocates and community members.
