Magellan Health Services of Arizona, the Regional Behavioral Health Authority for Maricopa County, is currently seeking three community representatives to serve on its shared Governance Board, the group responsible for shaping the vision and strategy, planning, decision-making and oversight of Maricopa County's Regional Behavioral Health Authority (RBHA).

Seats currently open are the adult recipient representative, children's provider organization/CEO representative, and the family member at large representative.

The 12-member Governance Board consists of six Maricopa County community representatives serving staggered terms, and six Magellan representatives. The Board was established to give community stakeholders a true voice and shared decision-making authority in the operation of the RBHA. The Board meets twice monthly on Wednesdays from 10:00 a.m. to noon at the Magellan of Arizona offices in Phoenix. Board meetings are open to the public.
